Description

IWPA presents, promotes, and manages World Heritage values in a manner that facilitates sustainable economic growth and development that is supportive of transformation in the tourism, conservation and research sectors whilst optimising environmental and commercial resources to empower historically disadvantaged communities in partnership with various stakeholders. iSimangaliso also leads in promoting the park as a preeminent tourism destination, as well as innovative and relevant research base consistent with conservation management principles.

iSimangaliso invites interested institutional leadership candidates to apply for the position of the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) who will build on the established success of this institution and transition it to a level of significance. The CEO will be reporting to the iSimangaliso Board, as Accounting Officer, through the Board Chairperson, and the successful incumbent will be primarily based at the iSimangaliso Wetland Park Authority offices in St. Lucia, northern KwaZulu-Natal.

Requirements
