- (1) Whether her department purchased any goods and/or services below the amount of R500 000 connected to the Covid-19 pandemic; if not, what is the position in this regard; if so, what (a) is the names of each company from which the specified goods and/or services were purchased, (b) is the amount of each transaction and (c) was the service and/or product that each company rendered;
- (2) whether there was any deviation from the standard supply chain management procedures in the specified transactions; if so, (a) why and (b) what are the relevant details in each case;
- (3) what were the reasons that the goods and/or services were purchased from the specified companies;
- (4) whether she will make a statement on the matter?

2. Yes, there was a deviation from the standard supply chain management procedures. The department utilised the Instruction Note 3 of 2016/17 paragraph 8.2 which states that “An emergency procurement may occur when there is a serious and unexpected situation that poses

an immediate risk to health, life, property or environment which calls an urgency to action and there is insufficient time to invite competitive bids” and Instruction note 5 of 2020/21 Emergency Procurement in response to National State of Disaster.

- (a) The department received cases of officials who were infected with COVID-19 and as a result the department had to disinfect the building as a matter of emergency.
- (b) The department approached 4x service providers to submit quotations on an emergency basis for each respective cases, and orders were issued to Orange Juice Investment Pty Ltd T/A X-Treme Cleaning Solutions and Hygiene & Buys R US as they submitted quotations that met the Department specifications.
